

Quantum Possum Choice Board

Grade Level: 6th Grade

Subject: English Language Arts

Based on the graphic novel, Quantum Possum, by Gina Gallois.

Back Cover Book Review

Design a back cover for Quantum Possum that includes a summary, your opinion, and a catchy tagline to attract readers.

Character Analysis

Choose a character and create a colorful poster that highlights their traits, motivations, and key moments.

Dialogue Role-Play

Write an original dialogue between two characters and act it out with a partner, incorporating props or costumes if possible.

Plot Summary Video

Create a short video or animation that summarizes the main events in Quantum Possum using visuals and narration.

Theme Exploration Art

Illustrate a theme from the graphic novel through a piece of artwork and include a short explanation of your choice.

Soundtrack for the Story

Curate a playlist of songs that represent the themes or characters of Quantum Possum and explain your choices in a brief write-up.

Setting Diorama

Build a diorama representing one of the settings in the graphic novel, including elements that showcase its importance to the story.

"...a future legendary superhero deserves a song or a poem, don't you think?" Make up your own rhyming song or poem, incorporating at least two words or phrases from the glossary.

Understanding Graphic Novels

Write an essay discussing how elements like illustrations, sound effects, and layouts in graphic novels enhance understanding compared to prose.

Figurative Language Hunt

Identify examples of figurative language in Quantum Possum and create a chart explaining their meanings and effects.


Rubric for Choice Board Assignments
